MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 04-2021

AN ORDINANCE PERMANENTLY CLOSING TO ALL TYPES OF VEHICLES PORTION OF BURGOS STREET LEFT SIDE FACING NORTH TO BE USED AS TRICYCLE TERMINAL IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF PINAMALAYAN, ORIENTAL MINDORO.

WHEREAS, Section 21 of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that a local government unit may, pursuant to an ordinance, permanently or temporary close or open any local road, alley, park or square falling within its jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, it is further emphasized also under Section 21 of the Local Government Code of 1991, that in case of permanent closure, such ordinance must be approved by at least two thirds (2/3) of all the members of the sanggunian, and when necessary, an adequate substitute for the public facility that is subject to closure is provided;

WHEREAS, Article IX, Section 50 of Municipal Ordinance No. 13-2020, the Pinamalayan Traffic Management and Enforcement Code authorizes the closure of portion of Burgos St. left side facing North purposely to utilize as Tricycle Terminal of the municipality;

WHEREAS, for the effective implementation of the Pinamalayan Traffic Management and Enforcement Code, the identification and designation of terminal area for tricycle is required subject to the guidelines of applicable laws;

WHEREAS, the primordial objective of this local statute is to balance the interests of the tricycle operators and drivers and the safety of the commuters;

NOW THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan of Pinamalayan in Session assembled that;

SECTION I. TITLE – This Ordinance shall be known and cited as the **Permanent Closure of Burgos Street for Tricycle Terminal of Pinamalayan.**

SECTION II. DECLARATION OF POLICY - It is a declared policy of the state to safeguard life and public welfare as mandated by Republic Act 7160 known as the Local Government Code of 1991. Section 21 of the same law authorizes the Municipal Government of Pinamalayan as this provides that a local government unit may, pursuant to an ordinance, permanently or temporary close or open any local road, alley, park or square falling within its jurisdiction and that when necessary, an adequate substitute for the public facility that is subject to closure is provided.

SECTION III. SCOPE OF APPLICATION – The portion of Burgos Street left side facing North is hereby permanently closed to all types of vehicles which shall be used as Tricycle Terminal of the Municipality of Pinamalayan with description as:

Burgos Street left side facing north with 19.00 linear meters width and

144.30 linear meters length.

AN ORDINANCE PERMANENTLY CLOSING TO ALL TYPES OF VEHICLES PORTION OF BURGOS STREET LEFT SIDE FACING NORTH TO BE USED AS TRICYCLE TERMINAL IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF PINAMALAYAN, ORIENTAL MINDORO.

WHEREAS, Section 21 of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that a local government unit may, pursuant to an ordinance, permanently or temporary close or open any local road, alley, park or square falling within its jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, it is further emphasized also under Section 21 of the Local Government Code of 1991, that in case of permanent closure, such ordinance must be approved by at least two thirds (2/3) of all the members of the sanggunian, and when necessary, an adequate substitute for the public facility that is subject to closure is provided;

WHEREAS, Article IX, Section 50 of Municipal Ordinance No. 13-2020, the Pinamalayan Traffic Management and Enforcement Code authorizes the closure of portion of Burgos St. left side facing North purposely to utilize as Tricycle Terminal of the municipality;

WHEREAS, for the effective implementation of the Pinamalayan Traffic Management and Enforcement Code, the identification and designation of terminal area for tricycle is required subject to the guidelines of applicable laws;
