ORDINANCE NO. 06-2020

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING CURFEW HOURS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF PINAMALAYAN, ORIENTAL MINDORO FROM EIGHT O'CLOCK IN THE EVENING (8:00 PM) TO FIVE O'CLOCK IN THE MORNING (5:00 AM) DURING THE IMPOSITION OF COMMUNITY QUARANTINE DUE TO COVID-19 AND PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support the promotion of health and safety, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants as provided in Section 16 of RA 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization declared the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) as a pandemic due to the rapid increase of cases of infection throughout the entire world;

WHEREAS, Presidential Proclamation No. 929, s. 2020, declaring a State of Calamity throughout the Philippines due to Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) dated March 16, 2020 placing Luzon under Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) and the rest of the country in a State of Public Health Emergency and upon the recommendation of the Inter-Agency Task Force for the management of Emerging Infectious Disease (IATF-EID) in its Joint Resolution No. 20, s. 2020 dated April 06 April 2020, the ECQ over the entire Luzon has been extended;

WHEREAS, national issuances mandate the local government units to approve measures and adopt quarantine regulations that would prevent the spread of diseases;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government of Pinamalayan is committed in protecting its constituents in most cases, the protection amid public health emergency and global pandemic situation in the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF PINAMALAYAN, ORIENTAL MINDORO, in session assembled, that:

Section 1. Imposition of Curfew Hours; Covered Persons: There is hereby imposed curfew hours for all persons in the Municipality of Pinamalayan, Oriental Mindoro between Eight O'clock in the evening (8:00 PM) to Five O'clock in the morning (5:00 AM) during the duration of the community quarantine due to Covid-19 and public health emergency imposed by the National Government.

During curfew hours, no person shall be allowed in the streets, commercial establishments, recreation centers, and any public places or other areas outside the immediate vicinity of their residence,

Section 2. Exemptions: The following persons in circumstances and cases shall not be covered under this ordinance:

- a) Those providing services in emergency cases such as MDRRM Personnel, Task Force identified or created by the Local Chief Executive;
- b) Those transporting for the purpose of slaughtering food animals to Municipal Slaughterhouse and public market;
- c) Those providing frontline functions, health and essential services during Covid-19 pandemic and health crisis and who may be allowed by the Local Chief Executive;

- d) Those transporting foods, essential goods and medicines;
- e) Peace and Order Personnel in both municipal and barangay levels;
- f) All elected Government Officials.
- g) Volunteers authorized and recognized by the Local Chief Executive through the recommendation of the Punong Barangay;
- h) Those who work at night or in a night shift duty such as Security guards, hospital personnel such as doctors, nurses, and other health personnel and ambulance drivers.
- i) Those assisting the necessary needs of medical patients

Section 3. Role of the Barangays: The Punong Barangay, members of the Barangay Council and duly designated barangay Tanods are hereby authorized to implement the provision of this Ordinance in their territorial jurisdiction. The Punong Barangay may be deputized to issue **Citation Ticket**.

Section 4. Guidelines in Apprehension: Offenders of the Ordinance shall be apprehended in accordance with the guidelines to implement provisions of this Ordinance.

1. The apprehending officials or officers shall, without necessary delay, shall hold the offender in the custody of barangay until the curfew hours expired.
2. For an offender who is not a resident of the barangay wherein he/she apprehended, the authorized/deputized official shall seek the assistance of the PNP for custody.
3. Payment of penalties shall be made within seventy-two (72) hours upon issuance of citation ticket to the Municipal Treasurer's Office during working hours.

Section 5. Role of the Philippine National Police (PNP): The Philippine National police shall provide police assistance to the Punong Barangays whenever needed for the enforcement and implementation of this Ordinance. The PNP is likewise deputized to issue **Citation Ticket**.

Section 6. Installation of Alarms or Sirens in all Barangay: All barangays are hereby enjoined to install or use in their respective territorial jurisdictions sufficient number of functional and loud alarms or sirens before the start of curfew hours.

Section 7. Penalties: Any person found violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be fined of the following penalties:

First Offense	-	Php 500.00
Second Offense	-	1,500.00
Third Offense	-	2,500.00
Fourth and subsequent offenses,		Imprisonment of One (1) month for each separate violation at the discretion of the court.

Section 8. Separability Clause: If any provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or inoperative, the other provisions not so declared shall remain in force and effect.

Section 9. Repealing Clause: All Ordinances, rules and regulations, or part thereof, whose provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.
