



MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 07-2020

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING GUIDELINES IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF COMMUNITY QUARANTINE AND STATE OF PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF PINAMALAYAN, ORIENTAL MINDORO AND IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support the promotion of health and safety, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants as provided in Section 16 of RA 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization declared the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) as a pandemic due to the rapid increase of cases of infection throughout the entire world;

WHEREAS, Presidential Proclamation No. 929, s. 2020, declaring a State of Calamity throughout the Philippines due to Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) dated March 16, 2020 placing Luzon under Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) and the rest of the country in a State of Public Health Emergency and upon the recommendation of the Inter-Agency Task Force for the management of Emerging Infectious Disease (IATF-EID) in its Joint Resolution No. 20, s. 2020 dated April 06 April 2020, the ECQ over the entire Luzon has been extended;

WHEREAS, Municipal Government of Pinamalayan had set directives consistent to the regulations and guidelines issued by the Provincial Government and the National Agencies anent the Covid-19 pandemic;

WHEREAS, such issuances mandate the local government units to approve measures and adopt quarantine regulations that would prevent the spread of diseases;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government of Pinamalayan is committed in protecting its constituents in most cases, the protection amid public health emergency and global pandemic situation in the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF PINAMALAYAN, ORIENTAL MINDORO, in session assembled, that:

Section 1. Administrative Provision: It shall be mandatory to all persons in the Municipality of Pinamalayan to observe the prescribed guidelines imposed during community quarantine and state of public health emergency.

Section 2. Coverage and Scope - The implementation of provisions of this Ordinance shall cover all persons, public and private entity, facility and utility for the duration of community quarantine and state of public health emergency imposed by the National Government.

Section 3. General Guidelines: The following Guidelines shall strictly be observed:

- A.** it shall be mandatory to all persons in the Municipality of Pinamalayan to observe one (1) meter **Social Distancing or Physical Distancing** in all times in public places, inside public and private facilities and utilities during the period of community quarantine and state of public health emergency.

- B. Market schedules of every barangays shall be established and determined by the Liga ng mga Barangay with one (1) member of household is allowed for marketing with corresponding **Travel/Quarantine Pass** issued by the barangays;
- C. All establishments shall be limited to a density of one (1) person for every sqm of unimpeded space. The total number of occupants shall include the employees of said establishments;
- D. The security personnel of concerned establishment or office shall make sure that queuing customers and clientele will be of at least one (1) meter apart, while waiting entry;
- E. Mass gatherings and any event or convening which brings together people at a certain place and at the same time are prohibited;
- F. Official meetings or sessions called by the Municipal Mayor, Sangguniang Bayan, Liga ng mga Barangay and other Government special bodies and functionaries, purposely to prevent the spread of Covid-19 are allowed, provided that such meetings and sessions shall observe physical distancing;
- G. All operated hospitals and clinics in the municipality shall observe one (1) patient- one (1) watcher policy;
- H. Visitations in all Detention Centers in the Municipality are suspended, except for judges, prosecutors, and lawyers;
- I. Persons with ages below twenty-one (21) years old and those sixty (60) years old and above, shall not be allowed to enter any establishment allowed to operate during the community quarantine, except for heads/representatives of families charged with purchasing food, medicines, and other essential items, as evidenced by the Travel/Quarantine Pass issued by their Barangays;
- J. Movements of employers, employees and workers of public and private establishments, farmers, fisherfolks and ambulant vendors shall follow physical distancing and while travelling to and from the workplace and when working;
- K. Ambulance and emergency vehicles must allow one (1) watcher to accompany the patient..
- L. Tricycles must not exceed one passenger in the side car, while backriding is not allowed with modular plastic cover in between the sidecar and the driver's seat.
- M. Motorcycles and bicycles are prohibited from having backride passengers;
- N. Private Cars will only be allowed one passenger to occupy the front passenger seat, while front-facing seats shall not exceed two (2) passengers per row;
- O. Public Utility Buses (PUBs), Public Utility Jeepneys (PUJs) and Multicabs should not exceed 50% or half of the vehicle's capacity, excluding driver and conductor;
- P. UV Express passenger load should not exceed two passengers per row, except for the driver's row where only one passenger is allowed;

- Q. Delivery Truck will only be allowed three (3) personnel, the driver, 2 helpers to be seated at the driver's row and at the back row or inside the truck;
- R. Strict home quarantine shall be observed in all households with exceptions provided in the Executive Order No. 31, series of 2020 from the Provincial Government of Oriental Mindoro.
- S. All frontline workers enumerated in Executive Order No. 31, series of 2020 from the Provincial Government of Oriental Mindoro are mandated to allow the unrestricted movements.
- T. Sectors allowed to function during the implementation of Community Quarantine and schemes of operation of sectors allowed and not allowed to function provided in the Executive Order No. 31, series of 2020 from the Provincial Government of Oriental Mindoro shall be observed.
- U. General precautionary health measures and health protocols relating to Covid-19 pandemic provided in the Executive Order No. 31, series of 2020 from the Provincial Government of Oriental Mindoro and related issuances from National Agencies shall be observed.
- V. Travel restrictions provided in the Executive Order No. 31, series of 2020 from the Provincial Government of Oriental Mindoro shall be observed.
- W. Guidelines on the provision for mandatory wearing of Face Masks or cloth masks at all times shall be provided under Municipal Ordinance No. 03-2020.
- X. Guidelines on the provision for Liquor ban during community quarantine shall be provided under Municipal Ordinance No. 04-2020.
- Y. Guideline on the provision for the imposition of Curfew Hours in the Municipality of Pinamalayan shall be provided under Municipal Ordinance No. 06-2020.

Section 4. Penalties: Any person found violating the provisions of this Ordinance except a violation of provision in W, X and Y under General Guidelines shall be fined of the following penalties:

First Offense	-	Php 300.00
Second Offense	-	500.00
Third Offense	-	1,000.00

Fourth and subsequent offenses, Imprisonment of One (1) month for each separate violation at the discretion of the court.

Section 5. Separability Clause: If any provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or inoperative, the other provisions not so declared shall remain in force and effect.

Section 6. Repealing Clause: All Ordinances, rules and regulations, or part thereof, whose provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.
