

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-114

RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2000-090 ENACTING AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS SUBJECT FOR TAXATION UNDER RA 7160 TO SECURE LICENSE REGISTRATION PLATE AS AN ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENT IN OBTAINING BUSINESS/MAYOR'S PERMIT IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF PINAMALAYAN.

WHEREAS, one of the rich sources of revenue which has been untapped is the requirement of securing license registration plate for every business establishment before starting and undertaking a business;

WHEREAS, under Section 147 and Section 447, Paragraph 3(1) of the LGC of 1991, the municipality may impose and collect reasonable fees and charges on business establishments;

WHEREAS, the rising demand for the delivery of basic services and the construction of infrastructure projects for the constituency, the municipality has to look for available sources of revenues for funding;

NOW THEREFORE:

Be it RESOLVED as it is HEREBY RESOLVED to enact-

ORDINANCE NO. 2000-04

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2000-02 REQUIRING ALL BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS SUBJECT FOR TAXATION UNDER RA 7160 TO SECURE LICENSE REGISTRATION PLATE AS AN ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENT IN OBTAINING BUSINESS/MAYOR'S PERMIT IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF PINAMALAYAN.

SECTION I. Renewal and registration of business. Before any person, partnership or corporation start and renews a business, he shall first secure license registration plate, with the payment of the sum of One Hundred Fifty Pesos (P150.00);

SECTION II. Duration of Permit Plate. License registration plate shall be permanent, however, it shall be renewed yearly on or before January 20, by the issuance of a sticker bearing the current year of operation. The amount of thirty pesos (P30.00) shall be charged as renewal fees;

SECTION III. Where to Display. The business permit and license registration plate shall be permanently and conspicuously displayed within the establishment or office as the case may be, clearly visible to the public;

SECTION IV. Penalty. Any violation of the provision of this Ordinance by any person or entity shall be penalized by a fine of not exceeding Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P2,500.00) or imprisonment of not more than six (6) months or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court. In case of partnership or corporation the president or manager thereof shall be liable for such violation;

SECTION V. Repealing Clause. Any ordinance, rules and regulations or portion thereof which is contrary for or inconsistent with this ordinance is hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly;

SECTION VI. Effectivity. This ordinance shall take effect upon approval.
