ORDINANCE NO. 08-97

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL FRANCHISE FEE AND SPECIFIC GUIDELINES COVERING ALL CABLE TELEVISION SYSTEMS IN PINAMALAYAN, ORIENTAL MINDORO.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Pinamalayan, that :

Section I. All newly-started Cable Television Systems in Pinamalayan shall pay an initial franchise fee of ₱10,000.00 per ₱500,000.00 authorized capital investment for a corporate applicant or an actual capital investment of ₱500,000.00 for partnership or a single proprietorship applicant. However, in the succeeding calendar year, regardless of the initial date of operation, the franchise fee shall be based on gross receipts for the preceding calendar year, or any fraction thereof.

Section II. All cable television systems shall be allowed to collect a minimum of ₱200.00 pesos basic subscribers fee per month for residential and the standard installation fee of ₱2,500.00 per subscriber, provided that the franchise fee shall not be allowed to increase the charge without previous application to and approval by the Sangguniang Bayan, and the Executive Office of Pinamalayan.

Section III. Aside from the various regulatory fee such as Mayor's Permit, engineering permit and other administrative charges imposed by the 1992 Revenue Code of Pinamalayan, the regular franchise fee of seventy-five percent (75%) of one percent (1%) of the gross revenue of the franchise from monthly subscription and installation fees shall be paid by the cable television systems granted the franchise in Pinamalayan as stipulated in Section I of this Ordinance.

Section IV. In the operation of the Community Access Channel, the Cable TV systems shall provide and be made available the community channel for free to the local government unit of Pinamalayan, its duly-accredited non-governmental organizations and people-based organizations and barangays for the exhibition or showing of public information and service program. Provided, however, that the station manager of the community access cable channel shall as far as practicable, coordinate program activities with the Municipal Culture and Arts Council Resolution No. 71-95, in so far as the said program activities concern welfare exhibition and public service, that should be consistent with standard norms of public morals and welfare.

Section V. The grant of the franchise to cable systems is a mere privilege and maybe withdrawn at anytime for any and all breach of terms and conditions provided in this ordinance.

Section VI. If for any reason, any section of this ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, other sections shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section VII. All ordinances, general orders, executive orders, letters of implementation, instruction, regulations or circulars inconsistent with any of the sections of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section VIII. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
