ORDINANCE NO. 08-96

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE AND EXECUTIVE TASK FORCE UNDER THE COMMITTEE ON HEALTH AND SANITATION TO MONITOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CLEANLINESS CAMPAIGN AND THE EXISTING ANTI-LITTERING ORDINANCE IN PINAMALAYAN, ORIENTAL MINDORO, PROVIDING FOR ITS COMPOSITION AND FUNCTIONS THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Pinamalayan, Oriental Mindoro, that :

Section I. Title. This Ordinance shall be known as the Joint Legislative and Executive Task Force under the Committee on Health and Sanitation that will monitor the cleanliness campaign and the anti-littering ordinance in Pinamalayan, Oriental Mindoro;

Section II. Composition and Meeting of the Joint Executive and Legislative Task Force.

- a. Composition : The Joint Legislative and Executive Task Force shall be composed of the Municipal Mayor and Municipal Health Officer as the Co-chairman, the Vice Mayor as the vice chairman, all the Sangguniang Bayan Members, the ABC President, the Municipal Planning and Development Officer (MPDO), the Chief of Police and the two Sanitary Inspectors as members.
- b. Meeting : The members of the Task Force upon initiation of the chairman, shall by resolution, fix the day, time and place of the regular meeting. The minimum number of meeting shall be once a month or as the need arises.

Section III. Function of the Joint Executive and Legislative Task Force :

1. To ensure the implementation of the cleanliness campaign and the anti-littering ordinance in Pinamalayan, Oriental Mindoro.
2. To come up with a scheme in monitoring the cleanliness drive in Pinamalayan, Oriental Mindoro.
3. To act as the legal force in the cleanliness campaign in major thoroughfares in Pinamalayan, especially the Poblacion streets which happen to be the show window of the Municipality of Pinamalayan.
4. To formulate a comprehensive plan whereby the vision to make Pinamalayan the cleanest town maybe realized.
5. To perform such other tasks as maybe incidental to carry out the duties and responsibilities of the task force.

Section IV. Separability Clause. If for any reason, any section of this ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, other sections shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section V. Repealing Clause. All ordinances, general orders, executive orders, letters of implementation, instruction regulations or circulars, inconsistent with any of the Section of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section VI. Effectivity Clause. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
