RESOLUTION NO. 58-96

RESOLUTION ENACTING AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE DISTANCE OF BEERHOUSES WITH REGARDS TO ITS LOCATION FROM ANY INSTITUTIONAL BUILDINGS AND RESIDENTIAL AREAS.

WHEREAS, there have been complaints regarding the nuisance created by these places from concerned citizens;

WHEREAS, these establishments have been the areas of uncontrolled situations and thus justifying the apprehensions of these citizens for their welfare;

WHEREAS, the establishment of these type of business will have a negative influence upon the youth of our community;

WHEREAS, upon serious consideration of this matter regarding the value of this type of establishment and having found nothing of serious consideration;

NOW THEREFORE :

On motion of Hon. SB Member Michael V. King and seconded by all -

ORDINANCE NO. 13-96

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE DISTANCE OF BEERHOUSES FROM ANY RESIDENTIAL AREAS AND INSTITUTIONAL BUILDING, PUBLIC MARKET, CHURCH, PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS AND LIKE IN THIS MUNICIPALITY AND IMPOSING PENALTY THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Pinamalayan, Oriental Mindoro that :

Section I. Regulating Act. No person or group of persons shall establish, maintain and or operate beerhouses within 200 meters of institutional buildings and or residential areas as described in the following provisions.

Section II. Definition. For interpretative purposes, the following words, as used in this ordinance, shall have the following meaning :

- A. Beerhouses. Establishments who serve beer and is a habitue of drinkers including those with lady receptionists, guest relation officers and those with table charges.
- B. Residential Areas. Densely populated areas such as subdivisions, closely grouped houses, and private villages.

Section III. Provisions. A) It is prohibited for any person or group of persons to establish, maintain and or operate these beerhouses within the radius of 200M from any of the prescribed and described of this ordinance. B) All duly licensed beerhouses, and those existing within the radius shall be given 30 days notice by the authority concerned to transfer said establishment, upon approval of this ordinance. C) The Chief of Police of the PNP Pinamalayan or any of his duly deputized personnel is hereby authorized to close down any beerhouse in the jurisdiction of the municipality which are in violation of any provision of this ordinance and to apprehend the owner/operator of said establishment.

Section IV. Penal Clause. Any person or group of person violating this ordinance shall be penalized by a fine of not less than 1,000 pesos but not more than 2,000 pesos or an imprisonment of not less than 10 days but not more than 15 days or both fine and imprisonment upon the discretion of the proper court.


Section VI. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
