



## Office of the Sangguniang Bayan

### Explanatory Note :

Drinking in the open air/space is considered by man as a good time. Sidewalks, alleys, streets, parks, thoroughfares and other open places are for the people to while away their leisure time. These places are specifically constructed for the public instead of being utilized for public undertakings like drinking or other merry-making. Liquors, intoxicating when taken in large quantities, leads to drunkenness and finally ends in trouble. To forestall this untoward incident this ordinance is enacted.

### ORDINANCE NO. 15-96

AN ORDINANCE BANNING THE DRINKING OF INTOXICATING LIQUORS ON SIDEWALKS, STREETS, ALLEYS, PARKS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Pinamalayan, Oriental Mindoro, that -

Section 1. Drinking of intoxicating liquors, like tuba, beer, gin and the like shall be banned in open spaces like sidewalks, streets, alleys, parks and other public places.

Section 2. For the purpose of this ordinance the following terms shall mean :

- a) Alley - a narrow back street or street corner (eskinita)
- b) sidewalk - place to walk at the side of the street
- c) parke - land set apart for the pleasure of the public

Section 3. Drinkers have to make sure that when they engage in drinking spree, they stay inside the house, snack parlors enclosure or structures made for the purpose.

Section 4. Drinking spree inside coffee shops, restaurants, night clubs and other structures made for the purpose are exempt from this ordinance.

Section 5. On special occasions like fiestas, Christmas parties, anniversaries, weddings and baptism, drinking may be allowed within the auditorium and home lots of the owners respectively.

Section 6. Any person who violates this ordinance shall be fined an amount of not less than one hundred pesos (P100.00) but not more than five hundred pesos (P500.00) or be put in prison for not less than one (1) day or not more than five (5) days at the discretion of the court.

Section 7. The police and the barangay officials shall be deployed in the said places to enforce the law.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after approval.


